

Criteria for Ralph Farquharson Award

Historical Background of the Award:

Ralph Farquharson was an active and the only male member of The Jamaica Nurses' Association of Florida, Inc. (JNAF) up to the time of his demise, who displayed exemplary qualities of caring and community involvement. JNAF members decided after his unexpected death in 1998, that this was a lasting way to honor him. The monetary award is \$500 and will be presented at the annual Nurses' Week service. The following criterion has been used to choose the awardees.

Student Candidate Requirements:

1. The candidate must be enrolled in a tertiary education system (2 to 4 year institution) and be the individual's first-degree. Proof of current enrollment must be supplied.
2. The candidate should be recommended by an association member and/or identified by a faculty member of the above.
3. The candidate can be of any discipline of study who displays a sense of community and caring in his/her school and/or social circle.
4. *The candidate should demonstrate financial hardship- a brief written statement/letter is required from the candidate.
5. *A statement must be submitted by the person recommending the candidate as to why this individual qualifies for the award.
6. Applications must be received by April 23, 2022
